

BEHAVIOUR & DISCIPLINE POLICY

SWS Music recognise that pupils choose to attend the school and teachers reward enthusiasm and hard work.

Recognition of achievement can be offered verbally to the pupil during or at the end of a lesson, written praise via the regular report system or through more formal awards during the school year.

Pupils are expected to be attentive, willing and participative in both group and individual lessons. Pupils have a duty of respect to their peers and their teachers.

In order to benefit fully from their lessons pupils are required to practice their instrument(s) during the week. Teachers are required to contact the Director of Music if a pupil's progress is being seriously compromised through lack of effort and/or practice.

Parents are requested to show an active interest in the lessons their child attends at SWS Music and to support their child in their practice schedule at home.

Use of Mobile Phones Use of mobile phones or any other electronic device is strictly forbidden during classes or individual tuition. The teacher can confiscate the device/handover to parent or guardian for the duration of the lesson.
